## LIVING HISTORY DISPLAY

The Avenger packed a lot of punch for the US Navy during World War II. Today it's a big bang for the buck at your event.



- The Avenger (aka "the Turkey") was the largest single engine aircraft of WWII standing tall at over 16 feet and 18,000 pounds, making it a prominent display at your event.
- Our CAF Avenger has a unique wing walk stairway allowing your spectators to access the top of the aircraft and view the cockpit and gun turret and doing so without the long lines of other displays.
- Unlike most museums we don't rope off our aircraft, spectators can safely walk around and touch the airplane.

The Avenger is the same type aircraft President George H.W. Bush piloted during WWII. Lieutenant Bush bailed out of his stricken Avenger during a bombing mission on a Japanese held island in the Pacific.



## **BOOKING THE AVENGER**



The TBM is a great value for event organizers. It's an authentic, flying warbird with great spectator and press appeal and a big conspicuous hands on static display at a reasonable price.

We also bring along our own "PX" offering toys and mementos for sale to spectators. The proceeds from PX sales and donations help keep this historic flying museum operational.
